

Atlantic halibut Hippoglossus hippoglossus PLEURONECTIDAE

Size: up to 240 cm (122 kg)

Peculiarities: eyes generally on the right side; tall lightly concave (1); arched lateral line (2).

Habitat: normally found in deep water on sandy and gravely bottom

Food: eats a wide variety of fishes, crustaceans and molluscs depending on the availability.

Enemies: ?

Relation to man: in great demand because of its tasty flesh.
