

American smelt Osmerus mordax OSMERIDAE

Size:	up to 30 cm
Peculiarities:	A short flap-like adipose fin (1). Mouth gapes behind the eye (2).
Habitat:	Smelts live in coastal waters, ascending streams for spawning in May.
Food:	Zooplankton and middle range crustaceans.
Enemies:	Cod, striped bass, salmon, seal, cormorant, and merganser.
Relation to man:	The smelt fishery is commercially important especially in the Gulf.
