Observations: Staff were enrolled in the food handling course during inspection. There must be one person per shift with a certificate when food is being prepared. Corrective Actions: CDI	Corrected
7.1	MI	Non-food contact equipment shall be constructed from materials that are suitable for their intended purpose and are durable, easily cleaned and free from any undesirable substance. Observations: Outside of cupboards must be resurfaced or replaced. The kitchen is being renovated and new cupboards are being installed.	September 10, 2025
8.2	MI	Staff must be able to demonstrate proper use of sanitizers and method for testing the solution. Observations: New test strips must be purchased. The paper is missing to verify the concentration of sanitizer and expiry date.	Immediately
9.2	MI	Hand washing stations shall be available in adequate number and located to facilitate convenient access by staff. Observations: Hand wash station is out of commission. A new island is in works to be installed with a new hand sink. This must be completed as soon as possible.	Immediately
