7.4	MI	Sanitizer concentration shall be verified daily to ensure that effective sanitizing is occurring. <b>Observations: No sanitizer log in place. Bucket bleach sanitizer solution was at 100ppm.</b> <b>Comment: Implement a log for staff to record daily sanitizer concentration measurements.</b>	Immediately
8.2	MA	Sanitizer bottles must be properly labelled and available in sufficient quantity to encourage appropriate regular use. <b>Observations: Sanitizer spray bottle was labelled incorrectly and the solution was at 500ppm. Staff indicated this solution is used solely for bleaching tea cups which are washed afterwards.</b> <b>Comment: Ensure the bottle is labelled accordingly and that the product is not used accidentally as food contact surface sanitizer.</b> <b>Corrective Actions: The operator labelled the bottle during the inspection.</b>	Corrected
13.2	MI	Openings to the outside shall be screened. <b>Observations: Door in the back storage room had a gap along the bottom.</b> <b>Comment: Install a weather strip to seal the potential pest entry point. For follow-up prior to the next routine inspection.</b>	Immediately
